## IMPORTANT TERMS

**Equity vs. Equality:** "Equality is giving everyone the same pair of shoes. Equity is giving everyone a pair of shoes that fits." (Rise to Win)

**Systems Change:** "Confronting root causes of issues (rather than symptoms) by transforming structures, customs, mindsets, power dynamics and policies, by strengthening collective power through the active collaboration of diverse people and organizations. This collaboration is rooted in shared goals to achieve lasting improvement to solve social problems at a local, national and global level." (Catalyst 2030)

"Research shows that racism has had a profound and negative impact on communities of color. The impact is pervasive and deeply embedded in our society and affects where one lives, learns, works, worships, and plays and creates inequities in access to a range of social and economic benefits—such as housing, education, wealth, and employment. 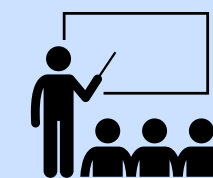

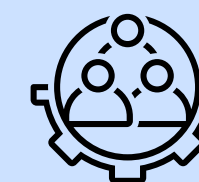
